Life is based on: "Speculation and experiments" i.e. the human being can't anticipate the results in such a domain, but he uses the experiment to determine the exact results or achievements. In Science fiction films, the director neglects a part of speculations and experiments; instead, he focuses on science accompanied by imagination and traps.

Of course, there is a big difference between "Realism" and "Imagination", but Man uses imagination only to escape from the brutality of life and **its** difficulties.
